We have been busy preparing for our MCA Tests.

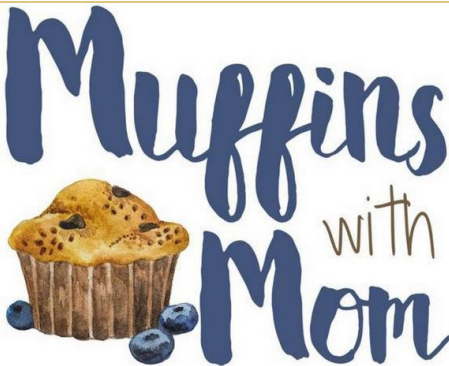
We are reading the novel "Where the Red Fern Grows". They are working on point of view, characterization, and figurative language.
