### Adopt a Highway



This coming Monday, April 25<sup>th</sup> at 6pm, we will be conducting our Adopt a Highway Cleanup on Hwy 210, between Motley and Staples, from the Four-Legged Lodge to 2 miles west (mile markers 112-114), both sides, not the median. Please consider helping. This event should take no more than an hour. However, the last 2 years it took 2 hours as there have only been 4 of us picking up refuse. This is fun and rewarding, but 2 hours does get long. We will also soon be finalizing the work to be done on the playground, by laying sod, planting trees and plants, and laying a strip of concrete between the basketball court and the play area. ### Spring Blast 2016 "Back to the 80's"



This year SHAS is hosting its 14<sup>th</sup> annual Spring Blast Auction and Dinner on May 7<sup>th</sup>. This is the social event of the year for our school/church and alumni community. There will be a live and silent auction, various raffles and games, full bar operated by our Knights of Columbus, and a chicken and pulled pork dinner by "Ted & Gen's". This year's theme is "Back to the 80's". We are anticipating one of our best Spring Blasts yet.

### Attendee Special Project Donation

The past seven years during the live auction we have had a special project donations request, requesting \$100 attendee donations. In 2010 we raised \$1,300 for a new interactive whiteboard, \$2,400 in 2011 for updated classroom lighting, \$3,300 in 2012 for concrete and materials for a new sidewalk in front of the school and up to the church, \$5,000 in 2013 for a secure front entrance to the school, \$5,000 in 2014 for library carpeting and north sidewalk, and \$3,000 in 2015 to go toward playground improvements. This year's special project donations will go toward a new seal coating for the school's roof.

### Severe Weather Preparedness

Last Thursday afternoon, SHAS students along with students around the country drilled for what they should do in case of a tornado or other severe weather. Students went to safe rooms on the lower levels of our two buildings practicing the protective position, to protect their heads and vital areas. Please practice storm safety at home as well.
