On Wednesday October 18th we had our 4th annual SHAS Work-athon. The event had us working at the city parks and cemetery. Preschoolers and kindergartners were on the Sacred Heart school grounds cleaning up the playgrounds. The first and second graders were at Northern Pacific Park a few blocks away raking leaves and picking up sticks. The third, fourth, and fifth graders were at Evergreen Hill Cemetery, removing overgrown sod from foot stones and raking leaves. The students learned about being respectful in the cemetery, realizing that all the monuments represent lost loved ones of others. Everyone had a great lesson in service to the community.
