SHAS teachers working with other teachers in the diocese

On Friday, October 14th, SHAS teachers and principal attended a diocesan hosted workshop on Marzano teaching strategies at Holy Trinity School in Pierz. The staff has been working on developing the school wide use of these strategies the past two years. This particular workshop focused on breaking down the state standards to develop the most comprehensive learning scales for students, which will be communicated in the classroom throughout units of learning. To sum it up, the staff is learning the most effective means of communicating to the students what they are expected to know, and be aware of what level of success they are at throughout their progress, providing ownership and motivation in their learning. Studies show these practices increase student learning dramatically. Last spring's SHAS test scores have indicated improvement from previous years. We will strive to continuously improve.

This week we have been working hard on science, math, and getting ready for Veteran's Day. In science we are learning about a plants life cycle. We know that a plant's life cycle differs from a person's life cycle because a plant will continue to grow throughout its life up until it dies. That means a plant can grow hundreds of feet tall unlike a person only getting 7 feet tall. We also learned that germinate means "to begin to grow". When the seed has the right amount of oxygen and water, and the right temperature, the seed will germinate.

In math, we are working on "area". We have mastered "perimeter" already, and we are really close to mastering "area" this week.

For Veteran's Day, we composed our very own poems. We created "poems for two voices" by first reading some books that had these types of poems, then we came up with a topic that we could write about that had to do with Veteran's Day, and researched the topic, and then put our words to paper. We worked really hard on these and we can't wait for the veterans to hear them. Hope you can make it too!
