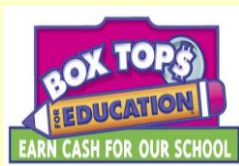

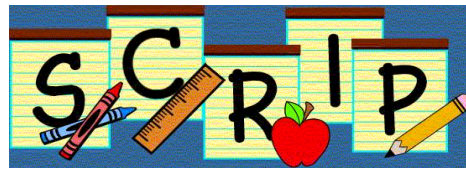

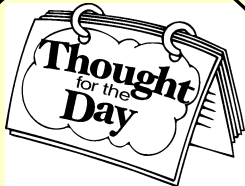
Raffle calendars were sent home on Tuesday. Please return money and stubs to Sandy by Monday, November 26th. Thank you!
