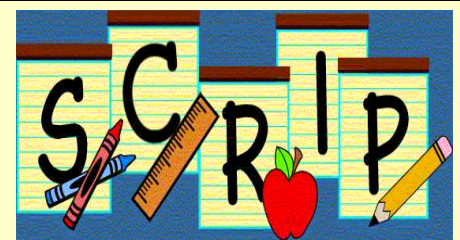

Volunteer Appreciation

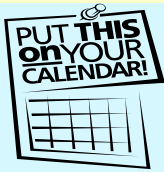
