What are we studying?

Reading, Language, Writing: We read *The Grinch* and read about its author, Dr. Seuss. In **Grammar** we are working with verbs. In **Writing**, we wrote a letter to our pen pals, and are working on a Bird report.

Math: After testing on Chapter 6, We are in Chapter 7, which emphasizes multiples of 10, 100, and 1,000, and multiplying 2 digit by 2 digit numbers.

Social Studies/Science: We continue to study the regions of the United States, and will memorize the states and capitals. In Science, we will do several activities that help us learn about animal survival. We will choose a bird to report on, and then a fish.

Religion: Because it's Advent , we will be learning about the 12 days of Christmas and what each number pertains to. We will continue to read the Gospel of Luke and journal on our readings. We will study the Beatitudes in Ch. 7 of our book.
