What are we studying?

Reading, Language, Writing: We will read the novel, Mr. Popper's Penguins, and will do a book study as we read. We sent new letters to our pen pals in New Jersey, and are writing letters to our parents thanking them for sending us to Sacred Heart. School.

Math: We are in Chapter 9 which emphasizes long division, with and without remainders. Practice Math facts with your children, as they should know these multiplication and division facts quite quickly.

Social Studies/Science: We continue to study the regions of the United States, specifically the **Southwest Region**, and will memorize the states and capitals. In Science, we will do several activities that help us learn about animal survival. We have chosen a bird to report on, and will then report on a fish.

Religion: Chapter 9 in our Book emphasizes honoring God with worship and respect. We are also doing activities that promote our School. We are acting out the parable of the Good Samaritan.
