What are we studying?


Reading, Language, Writing: We will read "Sailing Home, a story of a childhood at Sea", historical fiction. We will discuss and identify author's Purpose, and do sequencing of events. In Grammar we will work with adjectives and articles. We will write another letter to our New Jersey pen pals.

Math: We are beginning a chapter on geometry...studying lines, points, and angles, and geometric figures, Continue to drill your child on his/her math facts, as these do need to be automatic.

Social Studies/Science: We continue to study the regions of the United States, currently, the Midwest Region. Next, we will study the Western Region, which includes 11 states. We will be testing the States and Capitals in these regions, so help your child memorize these, by making a match game or flashcard drill. In Science, we will study machines and matter.

Religion: Chapter 12 in our Book emphasizes deepening our relationship with God and His Church. Feel free to read the Venture Magazine that comes home with your child.

We will continue to read from the Gospel of Luke, and to journal about what we read. We will read about the final days of Jesus (His death and Resurrection) in Luke chapters 22-24. Work on the 2nd part of last week's Bible verse. (John 15:11)
